Downloading Glary Utilities

1. Open your favorite browser and navigate to a Google search page.
2. Type “Glary Utilities Free ” into the search bar and click “Enter”. Click on “Glary Utilities/Glarysoft, downloading from “www.glarysoft.com”.
3. Click on the “Download Now” bar , be sure the “Download Now” bar you click on is for Glary Utilities and not some other Potentially Unwanted Program. If a “Save As” screen appears, click “Save”.

Chrome

- 4c. You should see a small rectangular box with the words “gu5setup.exe” in the left lower corner just above the Windows Task Bar. Once the blue circle around the icon to the right of the filename in this box disappears the download is complete.
- 5c. Put your mouse pointer on this box and click once with your left mouse button. If an “Open File - Security Warning” window opens click on “Run”. GO TO #6 below.

Firefox

- 4f. A window entitled “Opening gu5setup.exe” appears. Click “Save File”
- 5f. An arrow will fly up from the “Opening gu5setup.exe” window to the area just to the right of the search bar at the top right of the page. This arrow will turn blue when the download is complete. When it does, click on the arrow once with your left mouse button and a box will appear containing the installation file “gu5setup.exe”. Click on this box. If an “Open File - Security Warning” window opens click on “Run”. GO TO #6 below.

Internet Explorer

- 4i. When the download completes you will see a white box with an orange bar on the top located at the bottom of the screen that asks, “Do you want to run or save “gu5setup.exe” from “download.glarysoft.com?”
- 5i. Click “Run”. There may be a brief delay as a security scan is run on the download. GO TO #6 below.

Edge

- 4e. When the download completes you will see a white box at the bottom of the screen that asks, “What do you want to do with “gu5setup.exe” from “download.glarysoft.com” ?”
- 5e. Click “Run”. There may be a brief delay as a security scan is run on the download. GO TO #6 below.

6. If you see a notice on your screen stating “Windows protected your PC” click on “More Info” then click “Run anyway”.
7. When you see the User Account Control box asking “Do you want to allow the following program to make changes to this computer?” Click “Yes”. Now close your browser.

8. On the “Welcome to Glary Utilities” page click “Next”. Click “I Agree” on the license agreement page. Leave the destination folder unchanged and click “Next”. On the “Select Additional Tasks” page decide whether you want checks in the upper two boxes. Remove the check in the lower box. When you are happy with your choices click “Install”. The last page to open is the “Completing the Glary Utilities Set-up Wizard”. If you want to launch the program right away leave the check mark in the box next to “Run Glary Utilities”, if not remove this check mark. Click on the “Finish” button.
9. To update Glary Utilities open the program and click on the “Overview” tab at the top of the page. Insure there are check marks in the “Check for updates when program starts” and “Check for software updates automatically” boxes in the left column. The right column shows the current version, the database date, and the last update date. There is also a “Check for Updates” button here as well. Clicking on this will either update the program or notify you that you already have the most current update.
10. The second tab at the top of the page, just to the right of the “Overview” tab, is the “1-Click Maintenance” tab. Click on this to open the 1-Click Maintenance window.
11. On the left you will see several choices with check boxes. Make sure there are check marks in “Registry Cleaner”, “Shortcuts Fixer”, “Spyware Remover”, “Temp Files Cleaner”, and “Startup Manager.” If you want to erase your browser history as well place a check mark in “Tracks Eraser”. Remove all other check marks and click “Scan for Issues.” Once the scan is done click “Repair Problems.”

NOTE: If you have a SSD (Solid State Drive) you should omit steps 12-14. SSD’s should not be defragmented.

12. The third tab at the top of the page is the “Advanced Tools” tab. Click on this to open the Advanced Tools menu. Look to the right edge of the page and you will see two small circles, one of which is solid blue and one of which is a blue ring with a white center. If the top circle is not the solid blue circle place your mouse pointer on it and click ypour left mouse button and it should turn into the solid blue circle. Now look to the left of rhat page and you’ll see 5 choices, one of which is “Optimize & Improve”. Click on “Optimize & Improve”, then on the right side of the screen click on “Disk Defrag”.
13. Make sure that there is a check mark in the box corresponding to the C:/ drive. You may place check marks in all the other drive boxes as well.
14. Click the “Defrag” button under the drive names to start the defragmentation process.
15. Once this step is complete click the “X” in the small red box in the upper right corner of the program page to close the program.

Note: On all subsequent scans you should check the database date and last update date prior to running the program and if they are older than a few days click the “Check For Updates” button.
