

Chrome

Menu (⋮) > Settings > Scroll down to the “Search Engine” section

In the “Search Engine used in the Address Bar” section click on the caret to reveal your options and choose the one you want. If you don’t see the search engine you want click on “Manage Search Engines”. If the engine you prefer is listed click on the menu (⋮) icon and click on “Make Default”. If not, open the web page of the engine you want to use to add it to the list of “Other Search Engines” available, then return to the “Manage Search Engines” section and choose it. The next time you open Chrome and do a search from the address bar your chosen default engine will be used to run the search.

Firefox

Menu (≡) > Options (⚙) > Search

Scroll down to the “Default Search Engine” section and click on the caret next to the current search engine, choose the engine you want as your default. The next time you open Firefox and do a search from the address bar your chosen default engine will be used to run the search.

Edge

To change search engines in Edge first open the web page of the search engine you want to use, then:

Menu (⋮) > Settings

Click on the hamburger icon (≡) to the left of Settings. Click on “Privacy and services”

Scroll to the bottom of the page and click on the rightward pointing carat associated with the Address Bar item.

Click on the downward pointing carat associated with the “Search engine used in the address bar” item and select your preferred search engine. The next time you open Edge and do a search from the address bar your chosen default engine will be used to run the search.
