



Windows Timeline remembers what documents you've been working on and lists them in chronological order so you can reopen them and resume work where you left off. It will also keep track of web sites opened if you use Edge as your browser. To access your timeline click on the Task View icon directly to the right of the Cortana icon on the taskbar.

Windows Timeline is on by default. To turn it off do the following:

Start () > Settings () > Privacy > Activity History

Store my active history on this device - placing a check mark in this box turns Windows Timeline on, removing it turns Windows Timeline off.

Send my active history to Microsoft - placing a check mark in this box will sync your activities, and Timeline, across devices. If you sign in with the same account on another device you'll be able to pick up where you left off.
